Projects that will be considered eligible for the competition will be based upon topics related to Herculaneum (preferably) or other ancient sites around the Bay of Naples. Topics are not limited to archaeology, architecture, art history, conservation, history, historiography, papyrology, and philology. Use of funds to participate in existing field schools and photographic campaigns is also acceptable. Still further uses may be argued for in the applicant's description of project.

The application materials should include dates of activity, tentative budget (mentioning how AFoH funds may be used to defray costs), and acknowledgement of the expectation that a written report will be submitted for inclusion in *Herculaneum Archaeology*, the Friends of Herculaneum Society's newsletter.
